COMPOST SITE OPEN:

Saturday August 12 & August 26 from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. The Central Chester County Recycling Authority Compost Site is located at 2240 Upper Gap Road, Coatesville. Identification required.
Items accepted are leaves, vegetables, garden clippings, weeds, brush and limbs.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

Valley Township provides curb-side collection of yard waste during the months of June through October. If bagged, items must be in biodegradable bags. Tree limbs and branches must be cut to size, approximately 3 to 4 feet in length and bundled. The 2023 collection dates, weather and time permitting, are on the following dates (or the first available date thereafter):

North Side

August 14
September 11
October 9

South Side

August 21
September 18
October 16
