UTILITY BILLS:

FEBRUARY TOWNSHIP HOLIDAY/TRASH-RECYCLE SCHEDULE:

There will be no trash collection on Monday, February 21– collection will be on Tuesday, February 22 along with Tuesday's trash.

TRASH ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT

Residents have two options for trash containers: 32-gallon capacity cans, with lids and handles (weight cannot exceed 50 pounds) 48-gallon container which have all of the following:

- Recessed metal rod which allows cart tipper to dump container
- Must have lid
- Must have wheels



Total amount of trash collected per household will remain at 128 gallons which will still allow four 32-gallon containers or up to two 48-gallon containers and one 32-gallon container.
