#### TRASH BILLS:

The second quarter bills were mailed at the end of June. The discount period ends on July 15 at the close of business. Deadline for bills to be paid before penalty is assessed is August 1 at the close of business

\*\*Valley Township will not be responsible for misdirected or late mail. A secure drop box is available outside the main entrance to the Township Building (on righthand side of front door). Please ensure your payment, along with the remittance part of your bill, is in a sealed envelope. NO CASH! If you want a receipt mailed, please provide a stamped, self addressed envelope.

#### YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

Valley Township provides curb-side collection of yard waste during the months of June through October. If bagged, items must be in biodegradable bags. Tree limbs and branches must be cut to size, approximately 3 to 4 feet in length and bundled. The 2022 collection dates, weather and time permitting, are on the following
