REMINDER

You are required by law to call PA One Call at 811 or 1-800-242-1776 to locate gas, electric & telephone lines before you dig. Whether you are planting a tree, building a fence or laying foundation, contacting a line with a shovel or pick can damage utility lines and injure or kill.



Please check with the Township to ensure if a building or zoning permit is required. Building permits are required for new construction, additions, structural renovations, electrical work, basement renovations, decks, greater than 30" above grade in-ground and above-ground pools, plumbing, new mechanical systems, signage, grading, timber harvesting, retaining walls greater than 4 feet above grade, demolition and fireplaces/chimneys. Zoning permits are required, but not limited to, fences, sheds, carports, driveways and driveway expansions, patios and decks. The Codes Department has 15 business days to review, comment, deny or approve a Building Permit application and 30 business days to review, comment, deny or approve Zoning Permit applications.
