YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Valley Township provides curb-side collection of yard waste during the months of May through October. If bagged, items must be in biodegradable bags. Tree limbs and branches must be cut to size, approximately 3 to 4 feet in length and bundled. The first collection dates, weather and time permitting, are on the following dates (or the first available date thereafter):
