§ 10-102 DUMPING OR ACCUMULATION ON PUBLIC STREETS OR PROPERTY

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons,
firm or corporation to dump, cast, throw
discharge, keep, suffer to remain or cause or
permit to accumulate on any highway, street or
alley or any public property of the Township of
Valley any garbage or rubbish.

§ 20-107. Requirement of Commercial, Institutional and Municipal Recycling

1. All owners or occupants of commercial, institutional and municipal establishments within Valley Township shall separate, or cause to be separated, high-grade office paper, aluminum, corrugated paper, leaf waste, and such other recyclable materials as may be determined, from time to time, by resolution of the Valley township Board of Supervisors, generated at such establishments and/or from community activities, store the materials until collection by the Township or a licensed municipal waste collector, and, if collection made by a licensed municipal waste collector, annually provide written documentation and certification to Valley Township on or before January 31 of the total number of tons of materials, and the types of materials recycled during the previous year ending December 31. Such persons may comply with these reporting requirements by having their licensed municipal waste collector provide this information directly to the Township.
2. All owners or occupants of commercial, industrial or institutional establishments who gather yard waste shall separate it, or cause it to be separated, from solid waste and recyclables and place it for collection.
3. Burning of commercial, institutional or municipal yard waste is prohibited.

REMINDER

You are required by law to call **PA One Call at 811 or 1-800-242-1776** to locate gas, electric & telephone lines before you dig. Whether you are planting a tree, building a fence or laying foundation, contacting a line with a shovel or pick can damage utility lines and injure or kill. Please check with the Township to ensure if a building or zoning permit is required. Building permits are required for new construction, additions, structural renovations, electrical work, basement renovations, decks, greater than 30" above grade in-ground and above-ground pools, plumbing, new mechanical systems, signage, grading, timber harvesting, retaining walls greater than 4 feet above grade, demolition and fireplaces and chimneys. Zoning permits are required, but not limited to, fences, sheds, carports, driveways, driveway expansions, patios and decks. The Codes Dept. has 15 business days to review, comment, deny or approve a Building Permit application and 30 business days to review, comments, deny or approve Zoning Permit applications.
